



NSWIS Collection, Use and Disclosure of Personal Information

NSWIS will collect “personal information” (within the meaning of that term as defined in the *Privacy and Personal Information Act 1998* (NSW)) from and in respect of the Athlete during the Term

While the supply of the personal information by you is voluntary, if you cannot provide, or do not wish to provide, the personal information sought, NSWIS may not be able to continue to provide you with Scholarship Benefits.

The purposes for collecting the information are to:

- (a) assist NSWIS in considering and processing your application for a scholarship with NSWIS;
- (b) assist NSWIS in monitoring and maintaining a record of your performance during the period of the scholarship;
- (c) assist NSWIS in planning, monitoring and enhancing the provision of sporting services in respect to you and in respect to NSWIS generally;
- (d) assist NSWIS in understanding and researching the status and needs of athletes generally; and
- (e) ensure that NSWIS can comply and does comply with its obligations under the World Anti-Doping Code, including without limitation NSWIS’s obligations to the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Authority which NSWIS has undertaken or otherwise agreed to fulfil.

The intended recipients of the personal information are:

- (a) officers and employees of NSWIS;

- (b) sponsors of NSWIS;
- (c) members of the media;
- (d) the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Agency;
- (e) any other participating or sponsoring sporting organisations;
- (f) any other body who may require the information for administration purposes at the discretion of NSWIS, including agencies of the Commonwealth Government;
- (g) any relevant coach associated with NSWIS where such a coach is not an officer or employee of NSWIS.

You have right of access to the personal information, and a right to correct such personal information where appropriate, by contacting NSWIS.

Information stored on NSWIS's National ACE database can only be accessed by ACE/PD staff. All file notes on athletes are kept in a secure location with only ACE/PD staff gaining access for a period of five years.

The NSWIS is to be regarded as the agency that holds the information.

Consent to collection, use and disclosure of personal information

1. I hereby consent to the following:

- (a) collection of personal information by NSWIS or any person on behalf of NSWIS, including but not limited to personal information in the form of print material (including race results, rankings and other performance measures), electronic/digital photography and videotaping of my performance during my scholarship period whether at training or in competitions;
- (b) the use of personal information for the purposes detailed above in this Notice; and

(c) the disclosure of personal information to the recipients detailed above in this Notice as intended recipients including but limited to disclosure by means of publication in any suitable public medium (including the NSWIS website at www.nswis.com.au).

2. Collection, use and disclosure of the personal information by NSWIS shall at all times be in accordance with the provisions of the *Privacy and Personal Information Act* and the *Health Records and Information Privacy Act*.

3. I also authorise NSWIS to collect personal information from the following people and/or organisations:

- (a) medical practitioner; and
- (b) coaches.
