

TERMINATION OF NSWIS SCHOLARSHIP AGREEMENT

I acknowledge:

- 10.1 that this Agreement shall remain in force for the duration of the Term unless I serve NSWIS written notification that I wish to terminate the Agreement. I acknowledge and understand that if I terminate the Agreement before the end of the Term without reasonable grounds for doing so, as determined by the CEO, I may be required to repay to NSWIS the value of my Scholarship as assessed by NSWIS. A decision on whether I shall have to repay to NSWIS the value of my Scholarship is one which shall be made solely by the CEO of NSWIS exercising reasonable discretion.
- 10.2 that if I do not comply with the Anti-Doping Policy and the Code of Conduct and this Agreement, or if any declaration I have made is not true, or in the event of any breach of discipline or misbehaviour by me, this Agreement may be terminated immediately. I acknowledge that in such circumstances I may be required to repay to NSWIS the value of my Scholarship as assessed by NSWIS, where a decision on whether I shall have to repay to NSWIS the value of my Scholarship is one which shall be made solely by the CEO of NSWIS exercising reasonable discretion.
- 10.3 that should any medical condition prevent me from participating in the full training program the terms of this Agreement may be varied, suspended or terminated immediately by NSWIS;
- 10.4 that NSWIS may otherwise terminate this Agreement for any reason upon serving me with twenty-eight (28) days written notice.
- 10.5 that, during the Term, if I breach any terms or conditions of this Agreement, the Athlete Code of Conduct, or Anti-Doping Policy or any other NSWIS policy or procedure incorporated into this Agreement by reference, I will be subject to the procedures and disciplinary sanctions set forth in the NSWIS Athlete Disciplinary Guidelines in force from time to time and as amended.
