

Northern Soccer Workplacement Guidelines

NSWIS is an ideal place for students completing sport/exercise science degree to carry out work placement. The NSWIS Newcastle Soccer Program currently has an opportunity for university students to assist the coaching staff with its Women's and Men's programs.

Students will be required to assist with:

- Strength and conditioning testing for example. Beep and Yoyo tests
- Athlete results recording
- Field Training Sessions
- Speed and agility training

All workplacement activities will be carried out at the University of Newcastle and The Forum under Head Coach Wayne O'Sullivan.

Unfortunately, there are limited opportunities for students to participate in placement and NSWIS often have to decline requests. In order to provide students with the best and fairest opportunity to gain experience with us, the NSWIS have developed a process and set out guidelines for applying for a placement. NSWIS will not accept students for placement unless this process is followed.

- Initial contact must be made by the university staff member responsible for student placements (any attempts from students to contact NSWIS directly will not be successful)
- The university staff member must nominate the students for placements
- A maximum of 2 students from any one university will be approved (please note: this is not guaranteed, placement numbers will depend on numerous factors within NSWIS)
- Students must be in at least the second year of their sport/exercise science degree
- A time frame of when students will undertake placement must be provided
- **Applications must include:** current resume, university subjects/results, a copy of the university's public liability statement as well as the attached application form
- Applications must be in by 5th October 2009 of each year (note: placement may begin before this date if organised)
- Applications should be sent to the Human Resources Department via email: recruitment@nswis.com.au or faxed to (02) 9763 4551
- The NSWIS Human Resources Coordinator will liaise with the university staff member in regards to all applications

When universities are nominating students for placement, they should consider a range of attributes. NSWIS would hope to have students who not only display high academic capabilities, but also show initiative, have the ability to work both independently and with others, as well as displaying a passion for elite sport.
