

DEVELOPMENT ASSISTANCE FUND (DAF)

The Development Assistance Fund (DAF) managed by NSWIS The Athlete Wellbeing and Engagement Team to reimburse current NSWIS catergorised scholarship holders for costs incurred relating to personal, professional, career and education development and tutoring within the athlete's career and education plan.

ELIGIBILITY

- You are a current NSWIS catergorised scholarship holder.
- You are engaged in a current NSWIS Career & Education plan.
- You are currently enrolled in secondary, tertiary or vocational education.
- You meet the current Sport program requirements (IPP). *
- You have or plan to attend an Athlete Development Day or Athlete Development Sessions within the current financial year.**

AMOUNT

Up to \$400 (four hundred dollars) per financial year.

COVERED

- UAC Fees
- Study Materials and Stationary
- Tools of Trade
- Electronic Equipment and Software ***
- Tutoring assistance
- Short Courses, Accreditations, Certificates, Diplomas etc

Development Assistance Fund has a set budget each financial year. Once this has been fully spent in the current financial year, any further reimbursements requests will need to be resubmitted from 1 July in the next financial year.
